CB Energy is committed to providing and maintaining the highest attainable level of (OH&S) Occupational Health and Safety for our workers, subcontractors, suppliers and the public affected by our operations.

To demonstrate our commitment to safety we have adopted a target of ZERO Lost Time Injuries (LTI). Measured by LTIFR (Lost Time Injury Frequency Rate) and LTISR (Lost Time Injury Severity Rate).

CB Energy and all employees are responsible to ensure full compliance with all relevant WH&S legislation and comply with Australian Standards, industry standards and codes of practice.

In fulfilling this responsibility, CB Energy utilises its Accredited Management System compliant to AS/NZS ISO 4801: 2001 "Occupational health & safety management systems"

We encourage all workers and persons involved in our operations to regard accident prevention and working safely as both a collective and individual responsibility.

To clearly define accountability and ensure awareness, OH&S responsibilities are included in all duty statements, workers are trained during induction, through toolbox meetings, and in ad hoc and structured training.

To provide a tangible goal to workers LTIFR & LTISR are clearly communicated on a project and company wide basis.

To provide a clear demonstration of our commitment to OH&S Management, this policy and our LTIFR, LTISR outcomes are available to be viewed by interested parties such as clients and the public.
